- a) Live poultry, hold chicks and hatching eggs.
- b) Poultry meat and products thereof.
- c) Shell egg\
- d) Processed egg and products
- e) Poultry feathers

Accordingly, all the AQCS are advised to ensure that the consignments of poultry and poultry products imported from USA are cleared and provided NOC strictly as per the protocols and no testing and sampling shall be carried out as provided in the above said protocols.
