1. OIE listed pathogens:

This product is free from OIE listed pathogens for crustaceans viz. crayfish plague, NHP, IHHNV, IMNV, MrNV, TSV, WSSV and YHV (See Attachment 1). Occurrence of Acute hepatopancreatic necrosis disease (one of OIE listed pathogen for crustaceans) has never been confirmed in Japan.

2. Labeling:

This product has proper labeling for ensuring traceability.

3. Bacteria, antibiotics, and substances:

This product is free from pathogenic bacteria viz. salmonella, pathogenic vibrios, and antibiotics (Furazolidone, Nitrofurazone, Chloramphenicol). (See Attachment 2)

4. Antibiotics:

This product is free from antibiotics (Furazolidone, Nitrofurazone, Chloramphenicol). Japanese domestic law does not allow use of antibiotics in feed for aquaculture.

5. Moisture:

Moisture level of this product is less than 10%.

Steroid hormones and aflatoxins:

Steroid hormone (Estradiol) is absent and aflatoxins is less than 10ppb in this product. (See Attachment 2)

7. Composition of the ingredients and chemicals: Composition of the ingredients and chemicals are indicated on the label.

8. Mammalian meal and bone meal:

Fishmeal used for this product is free from mammalian meal and bone meal.
