**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

Subject: Implementation of "Risk Based Assessment" and "Delegation of power to Customs" –regarding.

The undersigned is directed to refer to the meeting held on 23.04.2015 under the chairmanship of Revenue Secretary to discuss the implementation of Risk Based Assessment and Delegation of power to Customs for drawing of samples.

2. It was decided that the department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying and Fisheries shall issue a list of products which require "Risk based inspection of good" and "Delegation of power to Customs for drawing of samples".

3. In this regard, two documents one is Risk Based inspection of consignments of livestock products and another is delegation of Customs for drawing of samples are enclosed for necessary action( Annexure I and II).

4. It is further informed that the sampling is highly technical job requiring technical skill, expertise and experience. Therefore, sampling and packaging should be carried out by Customs by taking all preventive measures to avoid any possible exposure of diseases as many diseases are zoonotic in nature. The Customs officials should be trained regularly in regard to sample collection and packaging as per standards. For training as above and also for integration of above documents viz Annexure I &II, **Dr. Vijay Kumar, Regional Officer, Animal Quarantine and Certification services, Kapashera, New Delhi** has been nominated as nodal officer. Risk Management System(RMS)

Article 7 of the Trade Facilitation Agreement allows the members countries to adopt principles of Risk Management System (RMS) to facilitate release of consignments. To implement RMS system for the imported consignments of livestock and livestock products those are regulated under Section 3 and Section 3A of live-stock importation Act. 1898, the products can be categorized as high risk, medium risk and low risk category based on the following:

- a) HS code,
- b) Nature and description of the goods,
- c) Country of origin,
- d) Country from which the goods were shipped,
- e) Value of the goods,
- f) Compliance record of traders,
- g) Type of means of transport.

The Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying and Fisheries (DADF) vide notification No. S.O. 2666(E) dated 17<sup>th</sup> October, 2014 has notified livestock products under Section 2(d) and also laid down the procedure of import of livestock products under Section 3A of the Livestock Importation Act, 1898. According to the said notification, the DADF issues Sanitary Import Permits (SIPs) after conducting import risk analysis of the livestock products to prevent ingress of diseases. The risk(s) involved in importing of any particular products are communicated through SIPs and also risk mitigation measures are attached in the form of health certificate. Presently, as per the notification, the livestock products have been categorized as follows:

- a) The livestock products which require SIPs and are cleared on the basis of NOC issued by the AQCS.
- b) The livestock products which do not require SIPs and are cleared on the basis of only NOC issued by the AQCS.
- c) The livestock products which neither require SIPs nor require NOCs from the AQCS are cleared by the Customs.

**A. The process for clearance of livestock products consignments which require SIPs is as under:**

- a) Importer files Bill of Entry to the Customs.
- b) The Customs refer the consignments to AQCS for clearing the consignments from AQ angle.
- c) The importer presents bill of entry referred by Customs along with all the documents in original like health certificate, test reports etc along with sealed Custom samples and register their application at AQCS.

- d) The Quarantine Officer verifies the compliance of the SIP requirements by the importers with regard to original health certificate and other health documents accompanied with the consignment.
- e) The physical examination of consignments is done based on the sample collected by the Customs for the purpose of clearance.
- f) AQCS collects the samples for testing of diseases as indicated in the post import requirements of SIPs and dispatches the same to the laboratory for testing.
- g) The Quarantine Officers sometimes test the products in case of doubt/random testing to counter verify the health conditions certified by the exporting country based on the disease situation of the exporting country vis-à-vis conducting post arrival risk analysis.
- h) The consignment under testing is put on hold at point of entry or released provisionally on bond /undertaking for keeping at Importer's premises till final clearance. This is done after conducting post arrival risk analysis, nature of the product, country of origin/dispatch of the product and health certificate compliance by the exporting country.
- i) The fulfillment of pre-import health guidelines and submission of original official health certificate as mentioned in SIPs/licenses is mandatory for final clearance. The original official health certificate from country of origin fulfilling the SIPs/licenses pre-import health guidelines are also checked in original before allowing testing and provisional clearance.

**B. Procedure for Clearance of the Consignments of livestock products which do not require SIPs is as under:**

As these items do not require SIPs, the importer can import the product without prior permission from the Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying and Fisheries, however, these livestock products consignments require clearance from AQCS. Therefore, after landing in India, the Customs refer these consignments to AQCS for clearance. The AQCS clearance process for these products is as under:

- a) Importer files Bill of Entry to the Customs.
- b) The Customs refer the consignments to AQCS for clearing the consignments from AQ angle.
- c) The importer brings referred bill of entry, all documents like original health certificate, test reports etc along with sealed Custom samples and register their application at AQCS.
- d) The Quarantine Officer checks the General Official health certificate in original (in case no stipulated guidelines) accompanied with the consignment.

- e) The physical identification of the products in the consignments is done on the basis samples received from Customs by AQCS.
- f) The consignment under testing wherever required in case of doubt/random testing is put on hold at point of entry or released provisionally on bond /undertaking for keeping at Importer's premises till final clearance. This is done after conducting post arrival risk analysis, nature of the product, country of origin/dispatch of the product and health certificate compliance by the exporting country.
- g) Physical inspection or testing of the consignments in these cases is conducted on random basis.
- h) The original health certificate issued by the Official Veterinarian of the country of origin is required before clearance of the product.

**Note:** AQCS works on the policy of single day decision. As per the records there is no delay in clearance at AQCS level.

Any document (s) found to be forged or not complying with India's requirements, AQCS will order for deportation or destruction of the consignment as the case may be.

**C.** The livestock products consignments those neither require Sanitary Import permit nor require NOC from the AQCS are cleared by the Customs without referring the consignments to AQCS as notified vide S.O 2666(E) dated 17<sup>th</sup> October, 2014.

**D. Introduction of Risk Based Inspection of livestock products consignments under Risk Management System (RMS)**

In view of ever increasing volumes, complexity of international trade and the challenging global bio-security scenario, India has to maintain its bio-security to safeguard their human and animal population against ingress of exotic diseases. With significant increase in per capita income and economic growth changing lifestyle and awareness about food nutrition, the quantum of import of livestock and livestock products has increased manifold. Resultantly, the chances of ingress of exotic diseases in the country have also increased which calls for regulatory mechanism without hampering the smooth flow of trade.

Department has established AQCS with the mandate to prevent ingress of disease through import of livestock and livestock products. In this regard, the consignments of livestock products are referred by the Customs for verification of compliance of SIP and other related requirements. Amongst the documents to be verified by AQCS, original official health certificates accompanied with the consignments issued by the exporting country need to be verified by the as this documents reflect the disease situation in the exporting country. The AQCS official will also inspect the custom sealed samples of goods for physical identification purpose. AQCS will draw samples for testing wherever required.

As a part of "Ease of Doing Business", initiatives of the Government of India in order to to cut down the Transaction Cost and to facilitate import clearance, DADF has decided to implement the system of "Risk Based Clearance of Consignments" of the imported livestock products mentioned in the list appended to this note. To implement this system the "livestock products" consignments have been categorized as under:

- a) The livestock products consignments which require risk based inspection of all cargo by AQCS.
- b) The products which require random risk based inspection by AQCS.
- c) The products which do not require inspection and can be cleared on the basis of original health documents by AQCS.

**Note:** AQCS is fully empowered and have the right in larger National interest to inspect any cargo of any product at any time as and when required under pre and post arrival risk analysis since the disease outbreaks and hazards cannot be predicted always in advance as new diseases are emerging and old diseases re-emerging in new mode, host, carrier etc.. There are many re-emerging diseases which can be transmitted to human and animal easily through the livestock products or the products can be infected at any stage like collection, storage, processing, handling, packing, and transportation etc. Therefore, the AQCS serves the right to inspect any consignments(s) under intimation to Customs and importer.

## Annexure II

### **Delegation of power to Customs officers for drawing samples from the consignments of livestock products**

The sampling is a highly technical job requiring technical skill, expertise and experience. There is also risk of exposure to various diseases dangerous to human and animal health. Many zoonotic diseases (transferable from livestock products to human being) can also be transmitted during storage, sampling and packaging. Moreover, packaging of samples for transportation to laboratory is also require expertise and has to follow specific international guidelines otherwise the results of testing of samples for diseases may give false positive or negative. Further, the sampling required for testing of diseases should be carried out in such a manner so that the results evolved from testing may give status of entire consignments.

2. The decision on testing of samples by the Quarantine Officer depends on the post import direction in the health certificate attached with the SIP/ license and sample testing criteria. Sometimes the consignment can be tested randomly under post arrival risk analysis.

3. To cut down the dwell time of any consignments and to facilitate clearance of livestock products consignments, the livestock products consignments has been identified authorizing the Customs to draw the samples for identification of products for clearance by AQCS. However, sampling and packaging should be carried out by Customs by taking all preventive measures to avoid any possible exposure of diseases as many diseases are zoonotic in nature. The Customs officials should be trained regularly keeping in view the existing rules and regulations. Training requirement may be communicated to **Dr. Vijay Kumar, Regional Officer, Animal Quarantine and Certification services, Kapashera, New Delhi** who is designated as nodal officer for this purpose.
